

Jax Cafe COVID-19 Safety Plan

Staff Preparedness Plan

- Review the list of COVID-19 symptoms and be aware of them at all times.
- If you have any symptoms or are sick, stay home from work.
- If you test positive for COVID-19 please follow protocols as posted.
- Before a work shift, all staff will be required to fill out a Health assessment questionnaire and have their temperature taken.
- All staff will wear face masks while at work, use gloves when appropriate, wash hands regularly and use sanitation stations.
- Staff will use personal styluses for ringing on the POS system to keep it a “no touch” procedure.
- Staff will show up to work in full uniform and only one person will be allowed in the locker room at a time.
- Mobile phones are not allowed on your person during your shift or in the pantry area.
- Refrain from touching hair, face or mask.
- Staff will keep social distancing as much as possible in common work areas.

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Guest Plan

- Jax Café is open for dinner-only service Tuesday - Sunday reservations only.
- If you are sick on the day of your reservation, we ask you to please stay home to mitigate the propagation.
- Please enter by way of door on University Ave and Exit by side door.
- Jax Café has several sanitation stations set up by all doors and other areas.
- All Jax Café staff will wear masks at work.
- Our Staff will wipe down chairs and tables after each use.
- Silverware will be rolled in napkins by staff with gloves after it is cleaned.
- Tables will be spaced 6 feet apart for social distancing.
- Table Size in the Dining Room & the Patio is limited to 10 people
- Bar counter seating is not yet available per order of the City of Minneapolis
- Bread and water service will be done by requests only
- No touch menus will be available via QR scan on your own Smartphone, otherwise we will provide a one use only menu for your convenience
- Please keep proper social distancing when checking in for your reservation.
- Bathrooms will be sanitized regularly.
- Jax Cafe is now equipped with a misting machine using a disinfectant that is hospital grade, non-toxic, food safe, no rinse required registered to kill the COVID-19 Virus.
